The KFP (Kirkby Fruit Project) is run by volunteers. We use surplus fruit to reduce waste, and produce juice, cordials, preserves, cider and cider vinegar for sale. The profits raised from the sale of our products throughout the year are used to help support local community groups. The funds are released from the end of year final profits. Each group can ask for up to **£600**, which is about 25% of our profits for **2022**.

All local community groups within 7 miles of Kirkbymoorside are welcome to ask for a donation to buy, or help you buy, a specific item/activity intended for the benefit of the members of their group. Requests will be considered, alongside others, by KFP and results will be announced in January. Unsuccessful bids can be resubmitted for the following year. Groups may apply for further donations in subsequent years. We would expect funds to be claimed and used within 6 months and would ask for a short report of how they were spent, that can be put on our website.
